Foundations of a Freedom Appointment

1: Prayer

• James 5:16 "The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective."

God can do, through prayer, what man cannot do. When engaging in a spiritual war, the weapon of prayer is mighty for pulling down strongholds. Prayer is a direct line to the God of the universe.

2: God's Word

- **2 Timothy 3:16** "All Scripture is God breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness."
- John 14:23 "Anyone who loves me will obey my teaching. My Father will love them, and we will come to them and make our home with them."

The Holy Bible is the only standard for righteousness and truth, and is absolute. When one walks according to God's word, it is a path that leads to peace. We encourage all who come for ministry to discover who they are in Jesus Christ by renewing their minds according to His truth.

3: Ministry Team

• **Mark 6:7** "Calling the Twelve to him, He began to send them out two by two and gave them authority over impure spirits."

Jesus set a good example in Scripture when He instructed believers to do ministry in groups of two or more. He gave them authority and power to bring the Gospel to the broken and lost. He did not want them to fight alone. We have adopted that ministry model.

4: Spiritual Gifts of the Holy Spirit

In 1 Corinthians 12, God reveals many spiritual gifts that will come as a result of the Holy Spirit being poured out upon His Bride, the church. We believe these gifts have not changed since they come from the Holy Spirit, who does not change.

The ABC's of Salvation

If you were to die today, do you know where you would go?

The Problem: We must **Admit** we are sinners. Everyone has done things that displease a Holy God; no one can live up to God's perfect standard. He also says that no sin can enter heaven; something must be done to get rid of our sin.

- Romans 3:10 "There is no one righteous, not even one."
- Romans 3:23 "All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God."



God's Solution: You must **Believe** Jesus died on the cross for you. God loves you and wants you to have a personal relationship with Him as His child. He loves you so much that He sent His Son, Jesus, to shed His blood to save you from the consequences of your sins. He took your place on the cross and suffered the punishment you deserve.

- **Romans 5:8** "But God demonstrates his own love for us in this; while we were still sinners, Christ died for us."
- **Romans 6:23** "For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Jesus Christ our Lord."
- **1 Peter 2:24** "He himself bore our sins" in His body on the cross, so that we might die to sins and live for righteousness; "by His wounds you have been healed."
- Acts 16:31 "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved"

Our Part: You must **Commit** your life to following Jesus. You must call upon Jesus to save you, and trust in Him as your Savior. This must be sincerely from your heart and expressed out loud.

- **Psalm 37:5-6** "Commit your way to the Lord; trust in Him and He will do this: He will make your righteous reward shine like the dawn, your vindication like the noonday sun."
- Acts 20:32 "Now, I commit you to God and to the Word of His grace, which can build you up and give you an inheritance among all those who are sanctified."

Prayer for Salvation

So, What Now...?

Many things happened when, as an act of your will, you received Christ by faith, including:

- Christ came into your life (Revelations 3:20, Colossians 1:27).
- Your sins have been forgiven (Colossians 1:14).
- You have become a child of God (John 1:12).
- You have received eternal life (John 5:24).
- You have begun a new life for which God created you (John 10:10).

Right now, you can ask Jesus to guide every part of your life..

Lord Jesus, I want to know You intimately. Thank You for dying for my sins on the cross. I open my heart and my life to You as my Savior and Lord. Thank You for forgiving me of my sins and giving me eternal life. I step off the throne of my life and want You to be in charge, make me the person you want me to be. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Do Not Depend on Feelings

The following drawing shows the relationship between **fact** (God and His Word), **faith** (our trust in God and His Word), and **feelings** (the result of our faith and obedience) - John 14:21.



The train will run with or without the caboose. It would be useless to attempt to pull the train by the caboose. In the same way, we should not let our feelings and emotions drive us, but instead, place our faith into the trustworthiness of God and the promises of His Word.



Galatians 5:1 says, "It is for freedom that Christ has set us free. Stand firm, then, and do not let yourselves be burdened again by a yoke of slavery." Since you have received Christ as your Savior and Lord, He has already set you free through His victory over sin and death on the cross.

The question is: Are you living victoriously in Christ's freedom, or are you still living in slavery?

Since you are a Christian already, your eternal life is not at stake; you are safe and secure in Christ. But your daily victory is at stake if you choose not to walk according to the Truth.

Only God is all-powerful, always present and all-knowing. Satan was defeated by Christ the Victor at the cross, so don't believe the lie that your situation is hopeless or that you are helpless against the devil's attacks.

Satan knows you have authority over him in Christ, but he doesn't want you to know it. Satan is the father of lies, and the only way he can have power over you is if you believe his lies. You may experience nagging thoughts such as, "This isn't going to work" or "God doesn't love me," etc. Don't believe the devil's lies.Remember, the only power Satan has over you is the power of the lie. Expose the lie then, choose the truth, and the power of that lie is broken.

Also, if you experience any physical discomfort, such as headache, nausea, tightness in the throat, excessive sleepiness, etc., don't be alarmed. Just let us know so we can pray for you. Don't let the devil set the agenda during this time; let the Holy Spirit lead.

Following is a prayer and declaration to get us started with the 7 Steps to Freedom. All prayers and declarations will be in bold and must be **read out loud**.

Opening Prayer

Dear Heavenly Father, I know that You are right here in this room with us and that You are present in my life right now. You are the only all-knowing, all-powerful, and ever-present God. I am completely dependent upon You because without Jesus Christ I can do nothing. I choose to stand in the truth of Your Word and I refuse to believe the devil's lies. I thank You that the risen Lord Jesus has all authority in heaven and on earth. I ask You to protect my mind and body during this time. Holy Spirit, please guide me into all truth. I choose to submit to Your guidance alone during this time. Please reveal to my mind everything that You want me to deal with today. I ask for, and trust in Your wisdom. I pray all this in faith, in the Name of Jesus. Amen.

Declaration

In the name and authority of the Lord Jesus Christ I command Satan and all evil spirits to release their hold on me in order that I can be free to know and choose to do the will of God. As a child of God, raised up and seated with Christ in the heavenly places, I declare that every enemy of the Lord Jesus Christ be bound. Satan and all his evil workers cannot inflict any pain or in any way prevent God's will from being done today because I belong to my Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ.

Remember that the Lord Jesus Christ has already purchased your freedom over Satan on the cross. Experiencing that freedom will be the result of what **you** choose to believe, confess, renounce, and forgive. No one can do that for you, not even God. The battle for your mind will only be won as you personally choose the Truth.

During each step, you will be taking a very thorough inventory of your life to make a commitment to the truth. If you are open and honest during this time, you will greatly benefit by experiencing the full freedom you have in Christ. May the Lord greatly touch your life during this time. He alone can and will give you the grace to make it through.

Step 1

Counterfeit vs. Real



The first step toward experiencing your freedom in Christ is to renounce all past or present involvement with occult, cult, or false religious teachings or practices. Participation in any group that denies that Jesus Christ is Lord and elevates any teaching or book to the level of the Bible (or above it) must be renounced. God does not take lightly false guidance. "I will set my face against anyone who turns to mediums and spiritists to prostitute themselves by following them, and I will cut them off from their people." Leviticus 20:6.

Dear Heavenly Father, please bring to my mind anything and everything that I have done, knowingly or unknowingly, that involves occult, cult, or false religious teachings and practices. Grant me the wisdom and grace to renounce any and all spiritual counterfeits. In Jesus' name, I pray. Amen.

The Lord may bring events to your mind that you have forgotten, even experiences you participated in as a game or thought were a joke. You may even have been passively or curiously watching others participate in counterfeit religious practices. The purpose is to renounce **all** counterfeit spiritual experiences and associated beliefs that God brings to your mind.

If something comes to your mind and you are not sure what to do about it, trust that the Spirit of God is answering the prayer you just prayed, and renounce it.

Idolatry

"Dear children, keep yourselves from idols." is the warning the apostle John gave us in 1 John 5:21. An idol is a false god, or any object of worship other than the one true God. Since we were created to worship the one true and living God, putting anyone or anything before Him is a sin.

Our Father seeks those who will worship Him in spirit and in truth (John 4:23). Though we may not bow down to statues, it is easy for us to make people and things of this world more important to us than the Lord Himself. *Now, pray this prayer to express your commitment to "Worship the Lord your God, and serve Him only." Matthew 4:10.*

Dear Heavenly Father, I know how easy it is to allow other things and other people to become more important to me, than You. I also know that this is terribly offensive to Your Holy eyes since You have commanded that I "Shall have no other gods before You". I repent of, and turn away from, this idolatry and now choose to return to You, Lord Jesus, as my first love once again. Please reveal to my mind now any and all idols in my life. I want to renounce each of them, cancel out any and all ground Satan may have gained in my life through idolatry. In the name of Jesus, the one true God. Amen.

Use the checklist below to help recognize those areas that have been a trap for you. Notice that most (if not all) of these areas are not evil in themselves; they become idols when they take God's rightful place as Lord of our lives.



Use the prayer below to renounce each area of idolatry.

In the Name of the true and living God, Jesus Christ, I renounce my worship of the false gods of ______. I choose to worship only You, Lord, and ask You, Father, to enable me to keep all these areas in their proper place in my life. I renounce idolatry and all its effects in my life. Thank You that I am forgiven. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Self-Protective Vows

It is critical to understand that a vow is never made outside of the context of a prayer. Often, as either an unconscious or willful reaction to painful life events, children, adolescents, and adults make "inner vows" (Matthew 5:33-37, James 5:12). An inner vow is defined as:

"An independent self-protective determination toward or away from a course of action and outside the will of God, set by the mind and heart into all of one's being."

When we make inner vows we are, in ignorance, making a prayer. Self-protecting vows are empty wells (Jeremiah 2:13) made outside the will of God, made unintentionally in agreement with the enemy, and destined to fail. Isaiah 28:15 says: "You boast, "We have entered into a covenant with death, with the realm of the dead we have made an agreement. When an overwhelming scourge sweeps by, it cannot touch us, for we have made a lie our refuge and falsehood our hiding place."

When we make these self-protective vows there is an evil one who "honors" that prayer and assigns his fallen companions alongside you to support the vow made outside the will of God. Every time you begin to jeopardize the self-protective vow through developing healthy, holy intimacy, there is one speaking in the ear, saying, "Remember, you promised to never let this happen!" *Ask the Holy Spirit to bring to mind any past or present self-protective vows.*

Holy Spirit, please reveal to my mind all self-protective inner vows I have made so that I may confess and renounce them. You are the only source of protection and provision I want and need. Amen.



Here are some examples of Self-Protective Vows. *Check all that apply and write in any others the Holy Spirit may bring to your mind:*

- □ "I will never be completely transparent."
- □ "I will never let anyone have my heart again."
- □ "I will not allow myself to need."
- □ "I will reject them before they reject me."
- "I will never be like my father (or mother)."
- □ "I must always stay in control."

Now that you've completed the checklists, renounce everything in the prayer below.

Heavenly Father, Thank You for revealing areas of fear and hurt in my life that I attempted to cover with lies. I know that You desire truth that sets me free. Father God, I recognize You as my ultimate authority, and I release to You the "kingdom" of self-protection I have built, including all my "I wills," "musts," "nevers," and "always." I ask, in Jesus' name, that You will bring Your power to heal any remaining hurts at the root of these inner vows. I repent of making these inner vows, and specifically renounce the vows _______ and declare that these inner vows are lies. I ask You, God, to rebuke all deceiving spirits and take back ground given over through sin. Father God, I ask You to help me trust Your protection instead of my own, and to trust Your ability to heal any pain You allow in my life. In Jesus' name, Amen.

Step 2

Truth vs. Deception



The Christian life is lived by faith according to what God says is true. Jesus is the Truth, the Holy Spirit is the Spirit of Truth, God's Word is truth, and we are to speak the truth in love (John 14:6, Ephesians 4:15). The biblical response to truth is faith, regardless of whether we feel it is true or not. Christians are to forsake all lying, deceiving, or stretching of the



truth, and anything else associated with falsehood. Believing lies will keep us in bondage. Choosing to believe the truth is what sets us free (John 8:32).

We can be honest and transparent before God, because we are already forgiven, and God already knows the thoughts and intentions of our hearts (Hebrews 4:13). So why not be honest and confess our sins?

Begin this commitment to truth by praying the following prayer. Don't let any opposing thoughts, such as "This is a waste of time" or "I wish I could believe this, but I can't" that keep you from pressing forward. God will strengthen you as you rely on Him.

Dear Heavenly Father, You are The Truth, and I desire to live by faith according to Your truth. The truth will set me free, but in many ways I have been deceived by the father of lies, and by myself. I choose to walk in the light, knowing that You love and accept me just as I am. I invite the Spirit of Truth to guide me. Please protect me from all deception as You "search me, O God, and know my heart; try me and know my anxious thoughts; and see if there be any hurtful way in me, and lead me in the everlasting way". In the name of Jesus, I pray. Amen. Prayerfully consider the lists in the three exercises on the next two pages, using the prayers at the end of each to confess any ways you have given in to deception or wrongly defended yourself. You can't instantly renew your mind, but the process will never get started without acknowledging your mental strongholds or defense mechanisms, also known as flesh patterns.

- Believing that I can sin and suffer no negative consequences. (Hebrews 3:12-13)
- Believing that I need more than Jesus to meet my needs. (2 Corinthians 11:2-4,13-15)
- Believing that I can do whatever I want regardless of others and still be free. (Proverbs 16:18, Obadiah 3, 1 Peter 5:5)
- Believing that I can associate with bad company and not become corrupted. (1 Corinthians 15:33-34)
- Believing that I can read, see, or listen to anything and not be corrupted. (Proverbs 4:23-27, Matthew 5:28)
- Believing that there are no earthly consequences for my sin. (Galatians 6:7-8)
- □ Believing that I must gain the approval of certain people in order to be happy. (Galatians 1:10)

- □ Lying (protecting self through falsehoods)
- □ Hypocrisy (presenting a false image)

Statements of Truth

Step 3

Bitterness vs. Forgiveness



We are called to be merciful just as our Heavenly Father is merciful (Luke 6:36) and forgive others as we have been forgiven (Ephesians 4:31). Doing so sets us free from our past and doesn't allow Satan to take advantage of us (2 Corinthians 2:10-11). *Ask God to bring to your mind the people you need to forgive by praying this prayer.*

Dear Heavenly Father, I thank You for the riches of Your kindness and patience towards me, knowing that Your kindness has led me to repentance. I confess that I have not shown that same kindness and patience toward those who have hurt or offended me. Instead, I have held onto my anger, bitterness, and resentment toward them. Please bring to my mind all the people I need to forgive to be totally free. In Jesus' name, I pray. Amen.

Forgiveness is not forgetting. People who want to forget all that was done to them will find they can't do it. When God says, He will remember our sins no more, He is saying that He will not use the past against us. Forgetting is a long-term by-product of forgiveness. Don't put off forgiving those who have hurt you, hoping the pain will go away. Once you choose to forgive someone, then Christ will begin to heal your wounds. We don't heal in order to forgive; we forgive in order to heal.

Forgiveness is a choice, a decision of the will. Some people hold on to their anger as a means of protecting themselves against further abuse, but all they are doing is hurting themselves. The Bible teaches, "Do not take revenge, my dear friends, but leave room for God's wrath, for it is written: "It is mine to avenge; I will repay, "says the Lord." Romans 12:19. Let God deal with the person. Let him or her off your hook because, as long as you refuse to forgive someone, you are still hooked to that person. You are still chained to your past, bound up in your bitterness. By forgiving, you let the other person off your hook, but they are not off God's hook.

"But you don't know how much this person hurt me!" No one but Jesus really knows our pain, and still He instructs us to forgive others for our own sake. Nobody can fix your past, but you can choose to be free from it. You gain freedom from your past and those who have abused you by forgiving.

Forgiveness is agreeing to live with the consequences of another person's sin. We are all living with the consequences of someone else's sin, so where's the justice? The cross makes forgiveness legally and morally right. Jesus died, taking our consequence upon Himself, for all our sins. "God made Him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in Him we might become the righteousness of God." 2 Corinthians 5:21. Do not wait for the other person to ask for your forgiveness. Remember, Jesus did not wait for those crucifying Him to apologize before He forgave them. Even while they mocked and jeered at Him, He prayed, "Father, forgive them; for they do not know what they are doing" Luke 23:34.

Forgive from your heart. Allow God to bring the painful memories to the surface and acknowledge how you feel toward those who've hurt you. If your forgiveness doesn't touch the emotional core of your life, it will be incomplete. Too often, we are afraid of the pain, so we bury our emotions deep down inside us. Let God bring them to the surface so He can heal those damaged emotions.

Forgiveness is choosing not to hold someone's sin against them anymore. It is common for bitter people to bring up past offenses with those who have hurt them. They want someone to feel as bad as they do! But we must let go of the past and choose to reject any thought of revenge. This doesn't mean you continue to put up with the abuse. God does not tolerate sin, and neither should you. Take a stand against sin while continuing to exercise grace and forgiveness toward those who hurt you.

Don't wait until you feel like forgiving. You will never get there. Make the hard choice to forgive even if you don't feel like it. Once you choose to forgive, Satan will lose his hold on you, and God will begin to heal your damaged emotions.



- **Ephesians 4:32** "Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you."
- Hebrews 10:30-31 "For we know Him who said "It is mine to avenge: I will repay" and again " The Lord will judge His people". It is a dreadful thing to fall into the hands of the living God."

Now, you are ready to begin to list the names of people who come to your mind. At this point, don't question whether you need to forgive them or not. If a name comes to mind, just write it down.

Often we hold things against ourselves as well, punishing ourselves for wrong choices we've made in the past. Write **"myself"** and be sure that you write down everything you have to accept forgiveness for, and all the feelings or sense of false identity that were created. Accepting God's forgiveness is accepting the truth that God has already forgiven you in Christ. If God forgives you, you are forgiven!

Also write, **"thoughts against God"** at the bottom of your list. Obviously, God has never done anything wrong so we don't have to forgive Him. Sometimes, however, we harbor angry thoughts against Him because He did not do what we wanted Him to do. Those feelings of anger or resentment against God can become a wall between Him and us so we must let them go.

Step 4

Rebellion vs. Submission



We live in rebellious times. Many people sit in judgment of those in authority over us, and only submit when it is convenient or because they fear being caught. The Bible instructs us to pray for those in authority over us (1 Timothy 2:1-2) and submit to governing authorities (Romans 13:1-7). Rebelling against God and His established positions of authority leaves us spiritually vulnerable. The only time God permits us to disobey earthly leaders is when they require us to do something morally wrong or attempt to rule outside the realm of their authority. *To have a submissive spirit and servant's heart, pray the following prayer.*

Dear Heavenly Father, You have said that rebellion is like the sin of witchcraft and arrogance like the evil of idolatry. I know that I have not always been submissive, but instead have rebelled in my heart against You and against those You have placed in authority over me in attitude and in action. Please show me all the ways I have been rebellious. I choose now to adopt a submissive spirit and a servant's heart. In Jesus' name, I pray. Amen.

It is an act of faith to trust God to work in our lives through leaders who are less than perfect, but God is asking us to do just that. Should those in positions of leadership abuse their authority and break the laws designed to protect innocent people, you need to seek help from a higher authority. Don't, however, assume that someone in authority is violating God's Word just because they are telling you to do something you don't like. God has set up specific lines of authority to protect us and give order to society. Without governing authorities, every society would be chaos. From the lists below, allow God to show you any specific ways you have been rebellious, and use the prayers that follow to confess those sins He brings to mind.

- □ Civil government (including traffic laws, tax laws, and attitude toward government officials), (Romans 13:1-7, 1 Timothy 2:1-4, 1 Peter 2:13-17)
- □ Parents, step-parents, or legal guardians (Ephesians 6:1-3)
- □ Teachers, coaches, school officials (Romans 13:1-4)
- Employers (past and present), (1 Peter 2:18-23)
- □ Husband (1 Peter 3:1-4) or wife (Ephesians 5:21, 1 Peter 3:7)
- □ Church leaders (Hebrews 13:7)
- □ God (Daniel 9:5-9)

Rebellion will often be expressed through an uncooperative attitude and a critical spirit. The following actions may stem from rebellion.

- □ Refusing to obey or follow legitimate instructions.
- □ Ignoring instructions or requirements or adjusting them to suit myself.
- Believing it is my right to criticize those in authority over me.
- □ Making critical statements about authority figures.
- □ Rejecting the advice of others who have experience and wisdom.
- Quickly finding fault with a people, groups or organizations, particularly those in authority.
- □ Reading a negative bias into things that those in authority say or do.
- Passing along negative information to others who are not part of the problem or solution.
- Withdrawing from communicating with others (often shown by short, clipped responses or silence).
- □ Speaking disrespectfully to another person or about another person.
- □ Having to "have the last word" in a conversation.
- □ Anything else the Holy Spirit may bring to your mind.

Step 5

Pride vs. Humility



Pride comes before a fall, but God gives grace to the humble (James 4:6, 1 Peter 5:1-10). Humility is confidence properly placed in God, and we are instructed to, "Put no confidence in the flesh" (Philippians 3:3). We are to be, "Strong in the Lord and in his mighty power." (Ephesians 6:10). Proverbs 3:5-7 urges us to, "Trust in the Lord with all our hearts and to not lean on our own understanding." *Use the following prayer to ask for God's guidance:*

Dear Heavenly Father, You have said that pride goes before destruction and an arrogant spirit before stumbling. I confess that I have focused on my own needs and desires and not those of others. I have not always denied myself, picked up my cross daily, and followed You. I have placed my will before Yours and centered my life around myself instead of You. I confess my pride and selfishness and pray that all ground gained in my life by the enemies of the Lord Jesus Christ would be canceled as I repent and overcome these sinful flesh patterns. I choose to rely upon the Holy Spirit's power and guidance so that I will do nothing from selfishness or empty conceit. I acknowledge You as my Lord, and confess that apart from You I can do nothing of lasting significance. Please examine my heart and show me the specific ways I have lived my life in pride. In the gentle and humble name of Jesus, I pray. Amen. Pray through the list below and use the prayer following to confess any sins of pride the Lord brings to mind.

Step 6

Bondage vs. Freedom



We often feel trapped in a vicious cycle of "sin confess, sin confess" that never seems to end, but God's promises say, "No temptation has overtaken you except what is common to mankind. And God is faithful; He will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, He will also provide a way out so that you can endure it." 1 Corinthians 10:13, and "Submit yourselves, then, to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you."

Sin that has become a habit often may require help from a trusted brother or sister in Christ. James 5:16 says, "Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective." Sometimes, the assurance of 1 John 1:9 is enough: "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness." Remember, confession is not saying, "I'm sorry." It is openly admitting, "I did it" *Whether you need help from other people or just the accountability of walking in the light before God, pray the following prayer.*

Dear Heavenly Father, You have told me to put on the Lord Jesus Christ and make no provision for the flesh in regard to its lust. I confess that I have given in to fleshly lusts that wage war against my soul. I thank You that in Christ my sins are already forgiven, but I have broken Your holy law, and I have allowed sin to wage war in my body. I come to You now to confess and renounce these sins of the flesh so that I might be cleansed and set free from the bondage of sin. Please reveal to my mind all the sins of the flesh I have committed and the ways I have grieved the Holy Spirit; so that I can repent. In Jesus' holy name, I pray. Amen.

- Galatians 5:19-21 "The acts of the flesh are obvious: sexual immorality, impurity and debauchery; idolatry and witchcraft; hatred, discord, jealousy, fits of rage, selfish ambition, dissensions, factions and envy; drunkenness, orgies, and the like. All these evils come from inside and defile a person."

Resolving Sexual Sin

It is our responsibility not to allow sin to have control over our bodies. We must not use our bodies or another person's body as an instrument of unrighteousness (Romans 6:12-13). Sexual immorality is sin against your body, the temple of the Holy Spirit (1 Corinthians 6:18-19). *To find freedom from sexual bondage, begin by praying the following prayer.*

Lord, I ask You to bring to my mind every moral failure and sexual use of my body as an instrument of unrighteousness, so I can renounce these sins right now. In Jesus' name, I pray. Amen.

Check each moral failure in which you participated and use the prayer following to confess.

Soul Ties

We are composed of three parts: body, spirit (where the Holy Spirit lives in us), and soul (our mind, will, and emotions). The soul, particularly the emotions, is the place we experience our deepest hurts in life.

To limit what the enemy can do to us through other people, it is often helpful to break the "ties" developed through former spiritual and emotional relationships with others. We refer to these as "soul ties," and they can have positive and negative elements.

Soul ties are defined by Charles Kraft in his book Deep Wounds, Deep Healing as this:

"Sometimes spiritual bonding happens when one person is dominated by another (including parents), when one strongly admires another, or when there is a very close friendship. Such relationships create what are often called 'soul ties'. These are spirit-to-spirit ties to other people which need to be broken if you are to be free. The steps (to break the ties) are...deal with any sin through confession, renounce in Jesus' name any tie empowered by Satan, claim Jesus' blessing on any part of the tie empowered by God, and forbid the enemy to continue to interfere in or make any further use of this relationship."

Negative soul ties are created every time there is any sexual relationship between two unmarried people. Sometimes, even natural relationships (ties), such as parents and children, can be used against us by our enemy. **Please note**: we are not trying to break relationships with others that are empowered by God, just any part of a relationship that has been empowered by the kingdom of darkness.

After praying the following prayer, make a list of the names of all persons with whom you have had a close relationship but also include an unhealthy dimension in your past. This may include any family members, all former sexual partners, close friends (even from childhood) therapists/doctors, special teachers, employers/co-workers, clients, etc. Remember, forgiveness must occur before a soul tie can be broken.

Dear Heavenly Father, please reveal and bring to my mind any relationship that has an unhealthy soul tie that needs to be dealt with today. Thank You in advance, for the freedom that You will give me through this. I pray this in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ. Amen.

After you have finished, commit your body to the Lord by praying.

Lord Jesus, I renounce all these uses of my body as an instrument of unrighteousness, and I admit to my willful participation. I choose now to present my eyes, mouth, mind, heart, hands, feet, and sexual organs to You as instruments of righteousness. I present my whole body to You as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable, and I choose to reserve the sexual use of my body for marriage only. I reject the devil's lie that my body is not clean or that it is dirty or any way unacceptable to You. Lord, Thank You that You have totally cleansed and forgiven me and that You love and accept me just the way I am. Therefore, I choose now to accept myself and my body as clean in Your eyes. In Jesus' name, Amen.



Special Prayers for Specific Situations

Pornography

Dear Heavenly Father, I confess that I have looked at sexually suggestive and pornographic material for the purpose of stimulating myself sexually. I have attempted to satisfy my lustful desires and polluted my body, soul and spirit. Thank You for cleansing me and for Your forgiveness. I renounce any satanic bonds that I have allowed in my life through the unrighteous use of my body and mind. Lord, I commit myself to destroy any objects in my possession that I have used for sexual stimulation, and to turn away from all media that is associated with my sexual sin. I commit myself to the renewing of my mind. In Jesus' name I pray. Amen.

Struggling Marriage

Dear Heavenly Father, I choose to believe that You created us male and female, and that marriage is a spiritual bond between one man and one woman who become one in Christ. I believe that bond can only be broken by death, adultery, or desertion by an unbelieving spouse. I choose to stay committed to my vows and to remain faithful to my spouse until physical death separates us. Give me the grace to be the spouse You created me to be, and enable me to love and respect my partner in marriage. I will seek to change only myself and accept my spouse as You have accepted me. Teach me how to speak the truth in love, to be merciful as You have been merciful to me, and to forgive as You have forgiven me. In Jesus' name I pray. Amen.

Divorce

Dear Heavenly Father, I have not been the spouse You created me to be, and I deeply regret that my marriage has failed. I choose to believe that You still love and accept me. I choose to believe that I am still Your child, and that Your desire for me is that I continue serving You and others in Your Kingdom. Give me the grace to overcome the disappointment and the emotional scars that I carry, and I ask the same for my ex-spouse. Enable me to learn from my mistakes and guide me so that I don't repeat the same old flesh patterns. I choose to believe the truth that I am accepted, secure, and significant in Christ. Please guide me to healthy relationships in Your Church, and keep me from seeking a marriage on the rebound. I trust You to supply all my needs in the future, and I commit myself to follow You. In Jesus' name I pray. Amen.

Abortion

Dear Heavenly Father, I confess that I was not a proper guardian of the life You entrusted to me, and I confess that I have sinned. I choose to accept the forgiveness that you have graciously given me. I commit the child to You for all eternity, and believe that they are in Your caring hands. In Jesus' name I pray. Amen.

Gender Identity

Dear Heavenly Father, I choose to believe that You have created all humanity to be either male or female and commanded us to maintain a distinction between the two genders. I confess that I have been influenced by the social pressures of this fallen world and the lies of Satan to question my biological gender identity. I renounce all the accusations and lies of Satan that would seek to convince me that I am somebody other than who You created me to be. I choose to believe and accept my biological gender identity, and I pray that You would heal my damaged emotions and enable me to be transformed by the renewing of my mind. I take up the full armor of God and the shield of faith to extinguish all the temptations and accusations of the evil one. I renounce any identities and labels that derive from my old nature, and I choose to believe that I am a new creation in Christ. In the wonderful name of Jesus I pray.

Suicidal Tendencies

Dear Heavenly Father, I renounce all suicidal thoughts and any attempts I've made to take my own life or in any way injure myself. I renounce the lie that life is hopeless and that I can find peace and freedom by taking my own life. Satan is a thief and comes to steal, kill, and destroy. I choose to remain alive in Christ who said He came to give me life and give it abundantly. Thank You for Your forgiveness. I choose to believe that there is always hope in Christ and that my Heavenly Father loves me. In Jesus' name I pray. Amen.

Substance Abuse

Dear Heavenly Father, I confess that I have misused substances for the purpose of pleasure, to escape reality, or to cope with difficult problems. I confess that I have abused my body and programmed my mind in harmful ways. I have quenched the Holy Spirit as well. Thank You for Your forgiveness. I renounce any satanic connection or influence in my life through my misuse of food or chemicals. I cast my anxieties onto Christ who loves me. I commit myself to yield no longer to substance abuse, but instead I choose to allow the Holy Spirit to direct and empower me. In Jesus' name I pray. Amen.

Eating Disorders or Self Mutilation

Dear Heavenly Father, I renounce the lie that my value as a person is dependent upon my appearance or performance. I renounce cutting or abusing myself, vomiting, using laxatives or starving myself as a means of being in control, altering my appearance, or trying to cleanse myself of evil. I announce that only the blood of the Lord Jesus Christ cleanses me from sin. I realize I have been bought with a price and my body, the temple of the Holy Spirit, belongs to God. Therefore, I choose to glorify God in my body. I renounce the lie that I am evil or that any part of my body is evil. Thank You that You accept me just the way I am in Christ. In Jesus' name I pray. Amen.

Drivenness and Perfectionism

Dear Heavenly Father, I renounce the lie that my sense of worth is dependent upon my ability to perform. I announce the truth that my identity and sense of worth are found in who I am as Your child. I choose to believe the truth that I have been saved, not by deeds done in righteousness, but according to Your mercy. I receive the free gift of life in Christ and choose to abide in Him. I renounce striving for perfection by living under the law. By Your grace, Heavenly Father, I choose from this day forward to walk by faith in the power of Your Holy Spirit according to what You have said is true. In Jesus' name I pray. Amen.

Gambling

Dear Heavenly Father, I confess that I have been a poor steward of the financial resources that have been in my possession. The love of money has driven me to behave irrationally and sinfully. I commit myself to stay away from all gambling casinos, gambling websites, bookmakers, and lottery sales. I choose to believe that I am alive in Christ and dead to sin. Thank you for your gift of the Holy Spirit so that I can resist the desires of the flesh. Show me the way to escape when I am tempted to return to my addictive behaviors. I stand against all of Satan's accusations, temptations, and deceptions by putting on the armor of God and standing firm in my faith. I choose to believe that You will meet all my needs according to Your riches in glory. In Jesus' name I pray. Amen.

Bigotry

Dear Heavenly Father, You have created all humanity in Your image. I confess that I have judged others by the color of their skin, their national origin, their social or economic status, their cultural differences, or their sexual orientation. I renounce racism, elitism, and sexism. I choose to believe "There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is neither male nor female, for you are all one in Christ". Please show me the roots of my own bigotry so that I may confess it and be cleansed from such defilement. I pledge myself "to walk in a manner worthy of the calling to which I have been called, with humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love, eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace". In Jesus' name I pray. Amen.

Homosexuality

Dear Heavenly Father, I renounce the lie that You have created me or anyone else to be homosexual and I agree that in Your Word you clearly forbid homosexual behavior. I choose to accept myself as a child of God and I thank You that You created me as a man / woman. I renounce all homosexual thoughts, urges, drives and acts, and renounce all ways that Satan has used these things to pervert my relationships. I announce that I am free in Christ to relate to the opposite sex and my own sex in the way that You intended. In Jesus' name I pray. Amen.

Overcoming Fear

Fear is a God given natural response when our physical or psychological safety is threatened. Fear always has an object, that is something or someone, and is perceived to have some power over us. It ceases to be a fear object when only one of those attributes is eliminated.

The fear of God is the beginning of wisdom. He is the ultimate fear object because He is omnipresent and omnipotent. The Lord Almighty is the one you are to regard as holy, He is the one you are to fear.

Courage is not the absence of fear. Courage is choosing to live by faith and doing what is right in the face of perceived fear-objects. Behind every irrational fear is a lie, which must be identified. Ask the Lord to reveal to your mind the nature of your fears and the irrational lies that compel them as follows.

Dear Heavenly Father, I confess that I have allowed fear to control my life. Thank You for Your forgiveness. I choose to believe that You have not given me a spirit of fear, but of power, love, and self-control. I renounce any spirit of fear operating in my life and ask You to reveal any and all controlling fears in my life and the lies behind them. I desire to live by faith according to what You have said is true in the power of the Holy Spirit. In Jesus' name I pray. Amen.

Overcoming Anxiety

Anxiety is different from fear, because it doesn't have an object. People are anxious because they are uncertain about an outcome or don't know what is going to happen tomorrow. It is normal to be concerned about things we value, but for some, the intensity and regularity of anxiety is out of proportion to the actual problem. We have been admonished to cast all our anxieties upon Jesus (1 Peter 5:7).

The root word for anxiety in scripture means "double mindedness". The first step to become single minded is to pray. "Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God." Philippians 4:6. *Ask God to guide you to overcoming anxiety with the following prayer:*

Dear Heavenly Father, I am Your child bought by the blood of the Lord Jesus Christ. I am completely dependent on You and I need You. I know that without Jesus I can do nothing. You know the thoughts and intentions in my heart and You know my situation from the beginning to the end. I feel as though I am double-minded, and I need Your peace to guard my heart and my mind. I humble myself before You and choose to trust You to exalt me at the right time in any way You choose. I trust You to meet all my needs according to Your riches in glory in Christ Jesus, and to guide me into all truth. Please guide me so that I can fulfill my calling to live a responsible life by faith in the power of Your Holy Spirit. "Search me, O God, and know my heart; try me and know my thoughts; and see if there be any hurtful way in me, and lead me in the everlasting way". In Jesus' precious name. Amen.

Step 7

Generational Sin



The Bible declares that the iniquities of one generation can be visited on to the third and fourth generations of those who hate God, but God's blessings will be poured out on thousands of generations of those who love and obey Him (Exodus 20:4-6). The iniquities of one generation can adversely affect future ones unless those sins are renounced, and your new spiritual heritage in Christ is claimed. You are not guilty of your ancestor's sins, but because of their sins you have been affected by their influence. Peter wrote that, "For you know that it was not with perishable things such as silver or gold that you were redeemed from the empty way of life handed down to you from your ancestors." 1 Peter 1:18. Ask the Lord to reveal your ancestral sins and then renounce them as follows.

Dear Heavenly Father, Please reveal to my mind all the sins of my ancestors that have been passed down through family lines. Since I am a new creation in Christ, I want to experience my freedom from those influences and walk in my new identity as a child of God. In Jesus' name, I pray. Amen. Listen carefully to what the Holy Spirit may reveal, and check anything that comes to your mind. Use the following prayer and declaration to reclaim your spiritual heritage.

Potential Areas of Generational Sins



I here and now reject and disown all the sins of my ancestors. I specifically renounce the sins of ______. As one who has been delivered from the domain of darkness and transferred into the kingdom of God's Son, I declare myself to be free from those harmful influences. I renounce any and all satanic attacks and assignments directed against me, my family, and my ministry. Every curse placed on me was broken when Christ died on the cross. I reject any and every way in which Satan may claim ownership of me. I belong to the Lord Jesus Christ, who purchased me with His own precious blood. I declare myself to be fully and eternally signed over and committed to the Lord Jesus Christ. I put on the armor of God and I stand against Satan's temptations, accusations, and deceptions. From this day forward, I will seek to do only the will of my Heavenly Father.

Dear Heavenly Father, I come to You as Your child, bought out of slavery to sin by the blood of the Lord Jesus Christ. You are the Lord of the universe and the Lord of my life. I submit my body to You as a living and holy sacrifice. May You be glorified through my life and body. I now ask You to fill me with Your Holy Spirit. I commit myself to the renewing of my mind in order that I may prove that Your will is good, acceptable, and perfect for me. I desire nothing more than to be like You. I pray and believe all this in the wonderful name of Jesus, my Lord and Savior. Amen.

Incomplete Resolution?

After you have completed The 7 Steps, close your eyes and sit silently for a minute or two. What do you hear? Most will sense the peace of God and a clear mind. A small percentage of believers don't, and usually, they know that there is still some unfinished business with God. If you believe that you have been totally honest with God and processed all 7 Steps to the best of your ability but still lack a sense of His complete peace, *then ask God as follows*.

Dear Heavenly Father, I earnestly desire Your presence, and I am asking You to reveal to my mind what is keeping me from fully experiencing Your freedom. I ask that You take me back to times of trauma in my life and show me the lies that I have believed. I pray that You will grant me the repentance that leads to a knowledge of the truth that will set me free. I humbly ask that You would heal my damaged emotions. In Jesus' name, I pray. Amen.

Don't spend your time trying to figure out what is wrong if nothing new surfaces. You are only responsible to deal with what you know. Instead, commit yourself to finding out who you are in Christ. If we show ourselves faithful in little things, God will put us in charge of bigger things.



Maintaining Your Freedom

It is exciting to experience your freedom in Christ, but what you have gained must be maintained. You have won an important battle; but the war goes on. To maintain your freedom in Christ and grow as a disciple of Jesus in the grace of God, you must continue renewing your mind to the truth of God's word. If more painful memories surface, then forgive those who hurt you and renounce any sinful part you played.

It is not uncommon after going through The Steps for people to have thoughts like: "Nothing has really changed, You're the same person You always were; It didn't work." In most cases you should just ignore it. We are not called to dispel the darkness, we are called to turn on the light. You don't get rid of negative thoughts by rebuking everyone, you get rid of them by repenting and choosing the truth.

To continue growing in the grace of God, we suggest:

- 1. Get rid of or destroy any cult or occult objects in your home. (Acts 19:18-20)
- 2. Read and meditate on the truth of God's Word each day.
- **3.** Go through *Who I am in Christ: The Study of the 33 Affirmations. (In Envelope)*
- **4.** Don't let your mind be passive, especially concerning what you watch and listen to. Actively take every thought captive to the obedience of Christ.
- **5.** Be a good steward of your health and develop a godly lifestyle of rest, exercise, and proper diet.
- 6. Don't drift to old patterns of thinking, feeling, and acting. This can happen very easily if you become spiritually and mentally lazy. If you are struggling with walking in truth, share your battles openly with a trusted friend who will pray for you and encourage you to stand firm.
- **7.** Don't expect other people to fight your battles for you. They can help you, but they can't think, pray, read the Bible, or choose the truth for you.
- Be part of a church where God's truth is taught with kindness and grace, and get involved in a small group where you can be honest and real.

- **9.** Participate in a Bible study. (*In Envelope*)
- **10.** Say the following daily prayer and read the "Who are you in Christ" statements on the bookmark in your packet for the next forty days. (*In Envelope*)
- **11.** Pray additional prayers in Step 6 for special needs.

I choose to believe the truth of God's Word despite what my feelings may say. Nothing is too difficult for You. I am confident that You will supply all my needs as I seek to live according to Your Word. I thank You that I can be content and live a responsible life through Christ, Who strengthens me. I now take my stand against Satan and command him and all his evil spirits to depart from me. I choose to put on the full armor of God so I may be able to stand firm against all the devil's schemes. I submit my body as a living and holy sacrifice to You, and choose to renew my mind by Your living Word. By doing so, I will be able to prove that Your will is good, acceptable, and perfect for me. In the name of my Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, I pray. Amen.

Bedtime Prayer

Heavenly Father, Thank You, that You have brought me into Your family and have blessed me with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus. Thank You for this time of renewal and refreshment through sleep. I accept it as one of Your blessings for Your children and I trust You to guard my mind and my body during my sleep. As I have thought about You and Your truth during the day, I choose to let those good thoughts continue in my mind while I am asleep. I commit myself to You for Your protection against every attempt of Satan and his demons to attack me during sleep. Guard my mind from nightmares. I renounce all fear and cast every anxiety upon You. May Your peace be upon this place of rest. In the name of the Lord Jesus Christ I pray. Amen.

Prayer for Spiritual Cleansing of Home

Dear Heavenly Father, I acknowledge that You are the Lord of heaven and earth. In Your sovereign power and love, You have entrusted many things to me. Thank You for this place to live. I claim my home as a place of spiritual safety for me and my family and ask for Your protection from all the attacks of the enemy. As a child of God, raised up and seated with Christ in the heavenly places, I command every evil spirit claiming ground in this place, based on the activities of past or present occupants, including me and my family, to leave and never return. I renounce all demonic assignments directed against this place. I ask You, Heavenly Father, to post Your holy angels around this place to guard it from any and all attempts of the enemy to enter and disturb Your purposes for me and my family. I thank You, Lord, for doing this in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ. Amen.

Prayer for living in a Non-Christian Environment

Thank You, Heavenly Father, for a place to live and to be renewed by sleep. I ask You to set aside my area as a place of spiritual safety for me. I renounce any allegiance given to false gods or spirits by other occupants. I renounce any claim to this space by Satan based on the activities of past or present occupants, including me. On the basis of my position as a child of God and joint heir with Christ, who has all authority in heaven and on earth, I command all evil spirits to leave this place and go straight to Jesus Christ for Him to deal with as He will. I ask You, Heavenly Father, to station Your holy angels to protect me while I live here. In Jesus' mighty name I pray. Amen.
